





# Call for doctoral grant 2021 – 2024

#### **PURPOSE OF THE CALL**

The Graduate School of Research in Economics and Management of Université Côte d'Azur (<a href="https://univ-cotedazur.eu/">https://univ-cotedazur.eu/</a>) is launching a call for doctoral grant (3 years) on a subject related to its research areas :

Innovation & Digital transformation, Sustainable innovation & ecological transition Dynamics of organizations and territories Financial innovation & innovation financing

### **CALL SETTLEMENT**

This grant is intended for candidates who are in the process of completing their post-graduate studies (Master 2, MSc in economics, management, business administration or sociology) or who have already completed one year of doctoral studies in these fields. Applications may be submitted in French or English. The grant recipient will commit to teach 40 hours per year in Graduate School programmes. The stipend is 44,000 euros gross per year.

## APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCESS

Applications should consist of:

- 1. A thesis proposal (10 pages maximum);
- 2. A cover letter from the EUR ELMI thesis supervisor (see the list of potential supervisor at: <a href="https://gredeg.univ-cotedazur.fr/presentation/les-membres-du-laboratoire">https://gredeg.univ-cotedazur.fr/presentation/les-membres-du-laboratoire</a> and <a href="https://www.skema.edu/research/research-centre/fairr/team-fairr">https://www.skema.edu/research/research-centre/fairr/team-fairr</a>) describing the link between the proposed topic and one of EUR's research areas;
- 3. The applicant's CV;
- 4. The applicant's Master's degree grades;
- 5. A motivation letter from the applicant;

Applications must be submitted to <u>Olivier.bruno@univ-cotedazur.fr</u> before June 21, 2021, at the latest.

The selection process is the following:

- 1. Proposals will be reviewed by an ad-hoc committee whose composition will be decided by the Strategic and Pedagogical Orientation Committee (COSP) and made public on the Graduate School website;
- 2. After the first selection, the selected candidates will be interviewed (in videoconference format) by the ad-hoc committee, which will make the final ranking. This ranking will then be validated by the Graduate School Steering Committee (COPIL).

## Call Schedule

April 26, 2021: launch of the call.

June 21, 2021: deadline for submission of applications.

Week of June 28, 2021: review of applications and candidates short list.

Week of July 05, 2021: interview with the candidates and notification of the results.
