Excellence Scholarships of the Graduate School of Economics and Management (EUR ELMI)

PURPOSE OF THE CALL

The Graduate School of Economics and Management (EUR ELMI) offers multidisciplinary courses of excellence in economics, management and sociology at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels. Nurtured by research and involved in many international projects, EUR ELMI wants to support the most talented students from all backgrounds, so that they can successfully participate in the EUR ELMI training programs.

For that purpose, EUR ELMI offers scholarships of excellence to high level students who wish to continue their undergraduate or postgraduate studies within one of its training programs.

CALL REGULATIONS

This scholarship, of an amount of 5,000 € per year, is offered for the 2026/2027 academic year. It will be paid in two installments : 50% at the beginning of the academic year and 50% upon validation of the first semester exams, or after the explicit validation of the faculty in charge of the training program (February).

The scholarship does not exempt the students from paying the registration fees, which remain their responsibility.

Any student (in initial training or alternance) enrolled in the 2nd or 3rd year of a Bachelor's degree, or the 1st year of a Master's degree during the 2025/2026 academic year, in a French or foreign higher education institute and who wishes to continue their studies in the 3rd year of the Economics and Management Bachelor's program or at EUR ELMI (1st or 2nd year of a Master's degree) is eligible for the Excellence Scholarship.

First-year students are not eligible. Second-year students who are awarded the excellence scholarship must complete the CIRE 2 (Certificate of Initiation to Research in Economics in the third year of the bachelor). There is no age limit or nationality requirement to apply for this scholarship.

The ELMI Excellence Scholarship cannot be combined with any other UniCA or IDEX Excellence Scholarship.

Students taking a gap year in 2026/2027 are not eligible for the EUR ELMI Excellence Scholarship.ça

The scholarship will be suspended in case of repeated and unjustified absence of the student whether it be for lectures, tutorials, or exams. It may also be withdrawn in the event of non-compliance with the institution's rules of procedure.

VALORIZATION AND COMMITMENT OF THE WINNERS

Beyond financial support, the Excellence Scholarship of the Graduate School of Economics and Management is part of a dynamic process of promoting and enhancing the profile of its recipients.

Scholarship recipients are fully involved in the life and visibility of the EUR. As such, they may be asked to participate in activities representing the department, particularly at institutional or academic events (student fairs, open houses, conferences, program promotion events).

Each year, profiles of the recipients are created and published on EUR's communication channels (website, social media, newsletters, brochures). This publicity helps to highlight their backgrounds, academic and professional projects, as well as the diversity and excellence of the profiles welcomed at EUR Economics and Management.

The awarding of the scholarship therefore implies active participation in this outreach initiative, in line with the values of excellence, openness, and commitment upheld by EUR Economics and Management.

APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCEDURES

The application must contain the following documents:

- The completed fact sheet
- A detailed CV
- If applicable, transcript of records of the diploma equivalent to the French Baccalaureate (final degree of secondary education)
- All transcript of records of higher education
- The academic project (cover letter)
- A copy of passport / ID
- **Optional** : Any evidence of financial hardship (tax notice, bank statement, grant certificate based on social criteria...)

All documents must be readable and sent in PDF format only (maximum volume: 20 MB). Incomplete or ineligible files will be automatically refused.

Application must be sent by email to eur-elmi@univ-cotedazur.fr before 15/04/2026.

The applications submitted will be examined by a committee composed of faculty members from EUR ELMI, which will make a first ranking. This will then be submitted to the EUR ELMI Steering Committee, which will carry out the final validation of the ranking and award the scholarship.

The evaluation committee will take into consideration the excellence of the candidate throughout his/her academic career, and the relevance of his/her professional and academic project. It will also be attentive to promoting diversity, based in particular on social criteria.
